What happens on a Ministry Trip?

The truth is anything can happen...and usually does, but that's what is so great about being on a trip. It is during times when we are not in complete control that God shows up. The idea is to stand alongside our brothers and sisters who are ministering in Malawi. Each day begins with devotions, then learning as together we teach and share. We usually taking part in trainings about things like healthcare, hygiene, and agriculture. We may participate in kids clubs, perhaps vocational training. You get to meet real people, experience what their life is like and share yours in return. Worship plays an important role, and most trips include a photo Safari too. The goal is always to make a difference in someone's life, usually trips make a profound difference in ours too.



Who goes on trips, when do they happen, and how long are they?

Churches often sponsor trips but many trips have open registration. Those going on trips are of all ages and walks of life, but they share a common desire to make a difference by investing in others. Trips usually occur during the Spring and Summer months and most are 10 days in length.

What does it cost, is their financial help?

The average cost is about \$3,700. Financial help is sometimes provided by churches but many use fundraising to help pay expenses.
